Seasons' Greetings Fellow DASC Members!

It's that time of year again where the show season ends and the holiday season begins. I would like to share my thanks to the outgoing board members. DASC has benefited greatly from their efforts. Special thanks and congratulations out to our new webmaster, Kevin Marshall, for designing USDF's Top GMO Website in 2009. And let's not forget to thank our Editor-in-Chief, Cheryl Pelly, for designing not one but two issues of Collected Comments in 2009, earning DASC the title and reserve title for top newsletter design. I was very pleased to accept the awards at the USDF Convention on their and DASC's behalf.

Let me bring you current on a few items of interest from the USDF Convention. USDF dues will be raised for the 2011 show season (beginning 12/1/2010). Participating membership will be increased to \$75 per year. If you ever considered a Lifetime membership, 2009 would be the year to upgrade. Right now it is \$1000--the pricetag goes up to \$1500 next year (that's a 50% increase!). I would highly recommend this for young Junior and Amateur riders who have a long career ahead of them in the show ring.

The USDF membership dues were raised via a vote from the Board of Governors, of which Dave Schmutz and I are delegates for DASC. Unfortunately, due to the economy, USDF's income suffered along with every other corporation. The deficit of \$240,000 had to be resolved, and the extra \$10 per membership solved that problem. This was not the only change. Committees and Councils were either combined or dissolved in the past calendar year, and sub-budgets cut. The USDF is currently operated by 36 employees and a tight budget for next year. We did also reallocate the interest income from money in savings toward next year's budget, from the National Championship Show Fund (which has yet to happen in this country).

On a more positive note--YEA scores are posted, and the Banquet is right around the corner--January 9th. Don't forget to verify your scores--you have until December 18th. Best of luck to everyone, and congratulations.....

## Whitney Harrington and Brooklyn.

Dear DASC,

Thank you so much for giving me the generous grant. Your grant enabled me to ride with Gunter Zach for 5 days.

Each day started at 8:00. We would start the morning with coffee and a brief overview of what we wanted to address for the day as well as our goals over the next few months. For me, it was continuing to bring along my new horse, Brooklyn. We have spent the last year reshaping and strengthening his body so that we may successfully train the upper level movements.

Gunter and I started like I always do. Getting Brooklyn long and low and really swinging through his back. Once really supple, I would start to close up his frame. We would constantly "check in" to make sure he was available. Like an accordion....sending him forward, bringing him back. Is he carrying me, or am I doing all the work? Making him really collect and sit at the canter. Is he popping his shoulder out? Or is he in between by legs, seat and hands? All these questions constantly being played in my head.

This is something I have learned over the last year with Gunter and my trainer, Jane Arrasmith. It's not just enough to ride all the time, but the internal dialogue you must have constantly with yourself and your horse. Every stride checking in. Is he available to me? Do I have equal weight in both stirrups? Are my shoulders square? Elbows bent? How can I remember all this? Don't they know I can't walk and chew gum?

X, Halt, Salute

## Christina Lauritsen and Poldy.

The August sun sets the fiery newcomer's copper coat alight. His lean jumping muscles reveal his recent work. This big chestnut has now come to us to embark upon a new career as a dressage horse. Today, we're addressing the halt. Since no one has ever cared how he stopped before, he's a little confused as to what all the fuss is about, but he's game to try.

He concentrates with all his might, his ears cocked back toward me. Not totally understanding what my leg, seat, and rein aids mean, this super-sensitive gelding wants to telescope his head into the air, drop his back, and slam his front feet into the ground to stop.

**Sue urges me to be quicker with my aids, "Be clear! You know how you want him to do it, show him."**

With my voice and seat I ask him to halt, but as he starts to plummet out from under me, I gently urge him forward

again. I repeat this until he anticipates that forward moment thus moving his white stockinged hind legs further under him as I ask for him to come back. A murmured "Good boy" rewards each successful attempt.

Then I still my hips and ask him for a complete halt. He still tenses his high-set neck a little against the rein, but yields quickly to a low softening hand.

Sue insists, **"Quick! React instantaneously, back and front. No time to think! Feel. Know what's going to happen"**

Rather than react to what's already happened, I'm pushed to anticipate and act sooner. She works on my timing as I teach this horse a new way.

We trot on and as I prepare the halt, I soften his neck further before he has time to think about tensing it. A difference of two steps and a breath. He steps under himself and stays soft through his back and neck into a balanced halt. "Good!" Sue calls. He's rewarded with a break and I pat his warm neck. He's so bright, he loves to please, and I'm proud of him.

Just two months later, the long shadows of October shade the warm-up arena of DASC's Mission Pacific show. I'm prepared for the endlessly energetic gelding to turn into a fire-breathing dragon. And yet, as we walk out of the barn he's completely nonchalant. His first dressage show, and he takes the whole thing—even the fountain and the horse-eating metal sculptures—in stride. His back swings and he stretches his long neck down during our warm up.

As we enter at A, Sue's words flash through my mind: No time to think. Feel what's happening... And I become a little more aware of the connection in my hand and cadence of his collected trot under my seat. My gloved fingers play the tiniest amount with his active mouth. He softens. A contraction of my muscles through my core and seat changes his motion. A quiet "whoa" slips off my exhaled breath. A compaction of power. His smooth sides yield to my leg pressure and the final steps of his hind hooves settle into a square halt. His first lesson pays off: his halts receive 8s.

Walking out on a long rein, receiving my gushing praise, the big smart chestnut looks so proud of himself.

### REMINDER TO ALL SHOW MANAGERS- SHOW RATING APPLICATIONS REQUIRED

Please remember that in the current USEF competition year, all shows are required to specify their competition rating. Shows are rated from level 1 to level 5. The current USEF Rulebook show the criteria needed for each level. Please apply for your rating level with the USEF Competition Dates office. Managers are further required to show their rating on the USEF Federation page which appears in each show premium. This is a new rule for the current competition year.

Fines are likely for competition management not in compliance.

# DASC Year End Awards Qualifications

For the levels of Training-Fourth Level, each horse/rider combination must earn a minimum six (6) scores by a minimum of three (3) different judges at any test in the level. Median score must be 58% or higher to qualify. Median score is equal to the average of the two middle scores earned out of a minimum six total scores. For all FEI levels, each horse/rider combination must earn a minimum of three scores by three different judges. Median score is equal to the average of the two middle scores earned out of a minimum of three total scores. Horse, rider and owner must all be paid DASC members, at time the scores are earned.
